Statement of Faith: There is one God, eternally existent in three persons: Father, Son, and Holy Spirit. Sexual activities, including but not limited to, adultery, premarital sex, homosexuality, and pedophilia, as well as, lascivious conduct, transgender behavior, and the creation and/or distribution and/or viewing of pornography are contrary to the teachings of the Bible and the Church.
